**Boarding at Trinity Manor: \$9,800**

**ANNUAL TUITION: \$23,800**

**Boarding with Host Family: \$8,400**

The total tuition is to be paid via cash, cashier's check, or certified U.S. funds prior to admission to the School. Funds that will be wired directly to the School's bank account must include an additional wire transfer fee of \$30.00. In addition, any account that has not paid in full by the due date will be assessed a \$200 late fee each month past due.

## **BOARDING FEES:**

The fee for boarding with a WCDS host family is \$8,400 for the school year. The fee for boarding at Trinity Manor house is \$9,800 for the school year. Payment of the fee is made directly to Wakefield Country Day School and is due no later than July 1st. In the event of the withdrawal of the student during the semester, or any change in boarding arrangements during the semester, no refund of the boarding fees will be made.

Boarding fees include coverage of the following expenses:

- Room and board with the host family or at Trinity Manor, during the school year with the exception of scheduled school vacations, i.e. Christmas Holidays, Winter Sports Week, and Spring Break. If the student wishes to stay with the host family or at Trinity Manor (with prior permission of the host family and the student's parents or guardian) during a scheduled school vacation, a fee of **\$35.00** per day will apply and be due in full prior to the beginning of the vacation.

\*We encourage our international students to attend the Winter Sports Break ski trip as the fees for the trip are included in their tuition.

\*Students should arrive no earlier than August 20, 2011 and should plan to depart the United States by June 3, 2012. Prep School Graduation and awards ceremony will be June 2, 2012.

The following expenses **are not included** in the boarding fee and are the responsibility of the student's parent(s) / guardian:

- Long distance phone calls
- Transportation above and beyond normal, day-to-day activities (i.e. trips to/from airport, ongoing professional appointments)
- Internet access/connection fees and charges
- Medical expenses not covered by student's insurance
